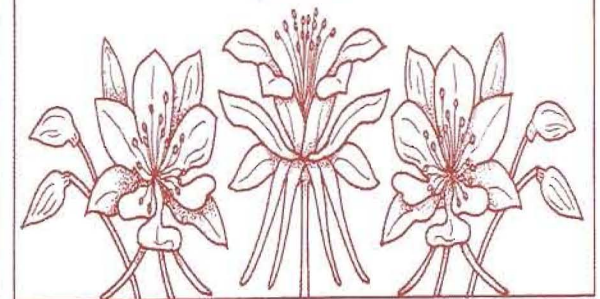

The Clear Lake Symphony, with Music Director, Dr. Charles Johnson, starts its 36th season in the fall of 2011. The Symphony, recognized as a premiere community orchestra, is a member of the American Symphony Orchestra League, Texas Association of Symphony Orchestras, Clear Lake Chamber of Commerce, ASCAP, and BMI. Its goals are to present classical music for the residents of the Bay Area and to provide opportunities for Bay Area musicians to create a variety of musical experiences for the enjoyment of the community. Six regular season performances including the Christmas "Pops" will be held featuring various classical selections and guest soloists.

Concerts will be held either at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church Auditorium, 18220 Upper Bay Road in Nassau Bay or at University of Houston, Clear Lake Bayou Building Auditorium at 7:30 PM (see concert dates).
